Mahamudra Art Projekt

We started creating the Mahamudra Art Project in 2014.

The project will consist of various elements, the focus being an installation art piece with an inner space of tsa tsas surrounded by paintings of the masters of Mahamudra. Extending outward, the design of the mandala continues with additional paintings.

With this project we would like to enable the viewer to experience and connect with the Buddha's teachings directly.

On June 11, 2015, selected Mahamudra paintings were shown in a first exhibit honoring H. H. Shamar Rinpoche at the Bodhi Path Center in Renchen Ulm. A portrait of Shamar Rinpoche is installed on his throne in the meditation room at the center in Renchen Ulm. Frank started work on this painting while Shamar Rinpoche was in Thugdam (June 2014).

Through the sale of these paintings, (listed in the Index) two-thirds of the proceeds go to the Mahamudra Art Project and one-third goes to dharma aid projects, such as Infinite Compassion.
